



Ad Since its introduction, AutoCAD has grown to become the most widely used and best-selling application of its type in the world, with over 2.3 million licenses sold. It has been a profitable business unit for Autodesk since 1993 and continues to grow in popularity. AutoCAD has recently been integrated with other programs from Autodesk, including ConceptDraw, D-Flow, Dynamic Input, Microsoft Office, and Autodesk 360. AutoCAD is an "all-in-one" package (GUI) that uses a specialized user interface (GUI). Development history In 1982, "Autodesk" was an acronym for "Automatic Computer Drafting", and the company was based in San Rafael, California. After the company's founders left, the company became known as "Autodesk Inc." (1992–2000), and it had offices in San Rafael, California and San Diego, California. Autodesk was founded by Ralph G. Graves, Brian P. Carney, and others. AutoCAD was originally written for the Apple II. It was the first commercially available desktop CAD system for personal computers, and it was available on Apple II computers (since 1983) and Commodore 64 computers (since 1984). The Apple II was chosen for this role because it was available in the early 1980s, and its main competitor, the IBM PC, was available later in the 1980s. When Apple introduced the Macintosh in 1984, Autodesk engineers worked with Apple to port AutoCAD to the Macintosh platform, using the same computer code as the
